INTER-PARLIAMENTARY UNION (IPU) RELATED ACTIVITIES

(A) REPRESENTATION OF INDIAN PARLIAMENTARY GROUP IN THE STATUTORY ASSEMBLIES OF THE INTER-PARLIAMENTARY UNION AND OTHER SPECIALIZED MEETINGS

1. <u>Fifth World Conference of Speakers of Parliament (5WCSP) organized in virtual</u> format on 19-20 August, 2020

The Fifth World Conference of Speakers of Parliament (5WCSP) was organised in virtual format by the Inter Parliamentary Union, (IPU) Geneva in collaboration with the Parliament of Austria and the United Nations Organisation on 19-20 August, 2020. Originally, the Conference was to be organised in physical format in Vienna, Austria in August, 2020. However, due to the COVID-19 pandemic the in-person Conference was postponed until September, 2021.

Parliamentary Delegation led by Shri Om Birla, Hon'ble Speaker Lok Sabha and consisting of Shri Rajiv Pratap Rudy, MP, Lok Sabha and Smt. Meenakashi Lekhi, MP, Lok Sabha participated in the above-mentioned Virtual Conference. Smt. Snehlata Shrivastava, Secretary General, Lok Sabha also attended the Conference.

The overall theme of the Conference was "Parliamentary leadership for more effective multilateralism that delivers peace and sustainable development for the people and planet". The agenda of the 5WCSP *inter-alia* included an Interactive Debate on 'Health, climate and the economy' and five thematic panel discussions on the following themes:

- (a) Stepping up parliamentary action: the climate change emergency;
- (b) Human mobility in pursuit of a better life: challenges, opportunities and solutions;
- (c) Improving governance by bridging the gap between Parliaments and the people;
- (d) Forging inclusive and sustainable economies that deliver well-being and justice for all; and
- (e) Countering terrorism and violent extremism: the perspective of victims.

The Indian Parliamentary Delegation attended the above mentioned five thematic Panel discussions. Hon'ble Speaker, Lok Sabha addressed the Conference on the theme "Improving Governance by bridging the gap between Parliament and people."

A Declaration was adopted at the end of the Conference.

2. <u>Virtual meeting of Mr. Duarte Pacheco, MP, Parliament of Portugal and Chairperson</u> of the Twelve Plus Geopolitical Group with Hon'ble Speaker, Lok Sabha on 25 <u>August, 2020</u>

On 25 August, 2020, Mr. Duarte Pacheco, MP, Parliament of Portugal and Chairperson of the Twelve Plus Geopolitical Group of IPU apprised Shri Om Birla, Hon'ble Speaker Lok Sabha about his candidacy for the next IPU Presidency (2020- 23) and sought support of Parliament of India for self.

3. <u>The 41st General Assembly of ASEAN Inter-Parliamentary Assembly (AIPA) held in</u> <u>virtual mode from 8-10 September, 2020</u>

The 41st General Assembly of ASEAN Inter-Parliamentary Assembly (AIPA) was held from 8-10 September, 2020 in virtual mode. The Assembly was organized by the National Assembly of Vietnam and AIPA Secretariat, Jakarta. The main theme of the Assembly was "Parliamentary Diplomacy for Cohesive and Responsive ASEAN". Dr. Satya Pal Singh, MP, Lok Sabha participated in the above Assembly.

4. <u>The 46th Session of the Steering Committee of Parliamentary Conference of World</u> <u>Trade Organization (PCWTO) held in virtual mode on 30 September, 2020</u>

The 46th Session of the Steering Committee of Parliamentary Conference of World Trade Organization (PCWTO) was organized in the virtual mode by the Inter Parliamentary Union, Geneva and European Parliament on 30 September 2020. During the Meeting, the Members of the Steering Committee *inter-alia* received an update on major developments at the WTO. Shri Rajiv Pratap Rudy, MP, Lok Sabha and member of Steering Committee of PCWTO participated in the interactive Session on 'the challenges and opportunities ahead'.

5. Sixth BRICS Parliamentary Forum held in virtual format on 27 October, 2020

The Sixth BRICS Parliamentary Forum was held in virtual format on 27 October, 2020. The Forum was chaired by the H.E. Vyachaslav Volodin, Chairman of the State Duma of the Federal Assembly of the Russian Federation. Speakers and members of five BRICS Parliaments, namely, Brazil, Russian Federation, India, China and South Africa participated in the Forum. An Indian Parliamentary Delegation led by Shri Om Birla, Hon'ble Speaker, Lok Sabha and consisting of Smt. Kanimozhi Karunanidhi, MP, Lok Sabha attended the Forum. Hon'ble Speaker, Lok Sabha addressed the said Forum on the theme "BRICS partnership in the interest of the global stability. General safety and innovative growth: Parliamentary dimension". Smt. Kanimozhi Karunanidhi, MP, Lok Sabha also delivered a statement. - 5 -

6. <u>Virtual meeting of Asia Pacific Group of IPU on 30 October, 2020</u>

An India Parliamentary Delegation led by Hon'ble Speaker Lok Sabha attended the virtual meeting of Asia Pacific Group of IPU on 30 October, 2020. During the meeting, the contenders for the post of IPU President (2020-23) presented their visions and agenda in order to seek the support of the members of the Group. The Presidency of the APG was also transferred from Parliament of Philippines to Parliament of South Korea for next one year's term.

7. <u>The 206th Session of the Governing Council (Extraordinary Virtual Session) of the</u> Inter-Parliamentary Union (IPU), Geneva from 1-3 November, 2020

The 206th Session of the Governing Council (Extraordinary Virtual Session) of the Inter-Parliamentary Union (IPU), Geneva was organized from 1-3 November, 2020. The agenda *interalia* included the election of the new President of IPU through remote electronic secret ballot, in order to replace the outgoing President of IPU, H.E. Gabriela Cuevas Barron.

An Indian Parliamentary Delegation led by Shri Om Birla, Hon'ble Speaker, Lok Sabha and consisting of Smt. Poonamben Hematbhai Maadam, MP, Lok Sabha and Shri Swapan Dasgupta, MP, Rajya Sabha participated in the above mentioned Virtual Session. Smt. Snehlata Shrivastava, Secretary General, Lok Sabha and Shri Desh Deepak Verma, Secretary General, Rajya Sabha also attended the Session. Dr, Ajay Kumar, Joint Secretary, Lok Sabha Secretariat was the Secretary to the Delegation. The Members of the Indian Parliamentary Delegation participated in the Virtual Session of the Governing Council and cast their votes.

At the end of the election, Mr. Duarte Pacheco, Member of Parliament from Portugal got elected as the President of IPU for the period of 2020-23.

8. <u>Parliamentary Webinar of the Steering Committee of Parliamentary Conference of</u> <u>World Trade organization (PCWTO) in virtual mode on 3 December, 2020</u>

A Parliamentary Webinar of Parliamentary Conference of World Trade Organisation (PCWTO) was organised by the IPU Secretariat, Geneva and European Parliament on 3 December, 2020. The theme of the said Webinar was "The global post COVID-19 economy: Devising sustainable trade policies to support the fight against poverty". An Indian Parliamentary Delegation consisting of Shri Rajiv Pratap Rudy, MP, Lok Sabha and Member of the Steering Committee of PCWTO participated in the Webinar.

9. The Sixth IRENA Legislators Forum held virtually on 13 January, 2021

The Sixth edition of the International Renewable Energy Agency (IRENA) Legislators Forum was held in virtual format on 13 January, 2021. The theme of the Forum was *Parliamentary actions to scale up renewable investments: renewable energy as an enabler of services*. Shri Chandra Sekhar Bellana, MP, Lok Sabha attended the Forum.

10. <u>Visit of H.E. Mr. Duarte Pacheco, President of Inter-Parliamentary Union (IPU),</u> <u>Geneva to India from 14-20 March, 2021</u>

On the special invitation of Shri Om Birla, Hon'ble Speaker, Lok Sabha, HE Mr. Duarte Pacheco, the IPU President, visited India from 14-20 March 2021, as his first port of call in Asia.

During his visit, IPU President called on Shri M. Venkaiah Naidu, Vice President and Hon'ble Chairman, Rajya Sabha, Shri Om Birla, Hon'ble Speaker, Lok Sabha, Dr. S. Jaishankar, Hon'ble Minister of External Affairs, and Shri Kiren Rijiju, Hon'ble Minister of Youth Affairs and Sports (Independent Charge), and interacted with Parliamentary Committee on External Affairs. The Visiting Dignitary also witnessed the proceedings of both the Houses of Parliament.

The IPU President also visited Goa and called on Shri Rajesh Patnekar, Hon'ble Speaker, Goa Legislative Assembly. Mr. Pacheco also met Shri Pramod Sawant, Hon'ble Chief Minister, Government of Goa and Shri Digambar Kamat, Leader of Opposition, Goa Legislative Assembly. The dignitary also visited Agra, where he was felicitated by Mayor of Agra City, Shri Naveen Jain and other prominent citizens and civil society groups.

(B) <u>CONTRIBUTION TO THE CENTRAL FUNDS OF THE INTER-PARLIAMENTARY</u> <u>UNION (IPU):</u>

Indian Parliamentary Group's Annual Contribution of CHF 1,12,900 (Rs.93,70,700/-) to the Central Fund of the Inter-Parliamentary Union for the year 2021-22 was paid out of the grant sanctioned by Parliament. Also, an amount of CHF 550 (Rs.44,825/-) has been contributed to ASGP.

(A) COMMONWEALTH PARLIAMENTARY ASSOCIATION (CPA) RELATED ACTIVITIES

1. <u>Video Conference of Hon'ble Speaker, Lok Sabha and Chairperson, All India</u> <u>Presiding Officers Conference with the Presiding Officers of Legislative Bodies in</u> <u>India on 21 April, 2020</u>

Hon'ble Speaker, Lok Sabha held a Video Conference on 21 April, 2020 with the Presiding Officers of State / UT Legislatures to discuss matters relating to COVID-19 Pandemic and other activities of Legislative Bodies in India. This Video Conference was held for the first time in the history of Indian Legislatures.

2. <u>COVID Control Rooms Grid</u>

In order to facilitate general public during COVID-19 pandemic, a Control Room was set up in Lok Sabha Secretariat as well in 23 State Legislatures to coordinate efforts of Parliamentarians and Legislators for relief and rehabilitation of affected people. The Lok Sabha Secretariat Control Room effectively handled more than 1000 cases relocating 11000 plus persons to their destination and also ensured assistance in the form of rations, health services, etc. The Control Room in Lok Sabha Secretariat was manned by CPA Cell, Conference Branch and IPU Cell. Further, the achievements of COVID Control Room in relocating general public and providing other assistance to people in distress were given suitable publicity through PPR Unit.

3. Publication on "Parliamentary Diplomacy" and "Sansadiya Smarika" on AIPOC

With a view to centre stage achievements of Parliamentary Diplomacy, Hon'ble Speaker, Lok Sabha has taken an initiative to bring out a Publication on "Parliamentary Diplomacy", including Speeches of Hon'ble Speaker at International Conferences / Meetings. A "Sansadiya Smarika" under the auspices of All India Presiding Officers' Conference (AIPOC) is also being brought out which will contain Articles from Presiding Officers, Parliamentarians and Legislators and former Presiding Officer's etc.

4. <u>CPA Mid-Year Executive Committee meeting held from 18-22 August, 2020 in Virtual</u> <u>Mode</u>

The CPA Mid-Year Executive Committee Meeting was held from 18-22 August, 2020 in Virtual Mode. Following three Regional Representatives from CPA India Region in the CPA Executive Committee attended the meeting:

- i. Shri Anurag Sharma, MP (Lok Sabha)
- ii. Shri Hitendra Nath Goswami, Speaker, Assam Legislative Assembly
- iii. Shri Prem Chand Aggarwal, Speaker, Uttarakhand Legislative Assembly

Besides the meeting of the CPA Executive Committee, Shri Anurag Sharma, MP (Lok Sabha) and Shri Hitendra Nath Goswami, Speaker, Assam Legislative Assembly attended the meeting of the Planning and Review Sub-Committee and Shri Prem Chand Aggarwal, Speaker, Uttarakhand Vidhan Sabha attended the meeting of the Finance Sub-Committee.

5. <u>The 80th All India Presiding Officers' Conference held in Kevadiya, Gujarat on 25-</u> 26 November, 2020

The 80th All India Presiding Officers' Conference was held in Kevadiya, Gujarat on 25-26 November, 2020. The Conference deliberated on the theme "Harmonious Coordination between Legislature, Executive and Judiciary - key to a Vibrant Democracy".

Shri Ram Nath Kovind, Hon'ble President of India inaugurated the Conference. Shri M. Venkaiah Naidu, Hon'ble Vice-President of India and Chairman, Rajya Sabha; Shri Acharya Devvrat, Governor, Gujarat; Shri Om Birla, Speaker, Lok Sabha and Chairperson of the Conference; Shri Vijay Rupani, Chief Minister of Gujarat; Shri Pralhad Joshi, Minister of Parliamentary Affairs and Minister of Coal and Steel, Government of India; Shri Adhir Ranjan Chowdhury, Leader of Congress Party in Lok Sabha; Shri Harivansh, Deputy Chairman, Rajya Sabha and Shri Rajendra Trivedi, Speaker, Gujarat Legislative Assembly attended and addressed the Inaugural Ceremony. 19 Speakers and 4 Deputy Speakers of State Legislatures attended the Conference.

Since the Conference coincided with the celebration of 71st Constitution Day, Hon'ble Rashtrapatiji read out the preamble of Constitution of India to the Nation on 26 November, 2020. All the Presiding Officers participated in this solemn occasion in the backdrop of Iron Man of India at the Statute of Unity.

During the Conference a resolution was adopted on "Constitution and Fundamental Duties". The Conference also took a number of decisions such as instituting Outstanding Legislature Award and celebrating Centenary Year of AIPOC as a Festival of Democracy.

Hon'ble Prime Minister gave valedictory address of the Conference through video conference. Shri Acharya Devvrat, Hon'ble Governor, Gujarat, Shri Om Birla, Speaker, Lok Sabha and Chairperson of the Conference and Shri Harivansh, Hon'ble Deputy Chairman, Rajya Sabha also addressed the Valedictory Session of the Conference. Shri Arjun Ram Meghwal, Minister of State in the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs; and Minister of State in the Ministry of Heavy Industries and Public Enterprises also attended the Conference.

6. <u>Standing Committee Meeting of Conference of Speakers and Presiding Officers of</u> <u>the Commonwealth (CSPOC) held virtually on Monday, 18 January, 2021</u>

The Standing Committee Meeting of the Conference of Speakers and Presiding Officers of the Commonwealth (CSPOC) was held virtually on 18 January, 2021.

Shri Om Birla, Hon'ble Speaker, Lok Sabha, member of the Standing Committee of CSPOC and Shri Utpal Kumar Singh, Secretary General, Lok Sabha attended the Meeting.

The main objective of the Meeting was to finalise the Agenda topics for the 26thCSPOC scheduled to be held in Australia in January, 2022. For the consideration of the Standing Committee of CSPOC, Hon'ble Speaker, Lok Sabha suggested 3 topics *viz. (i) Enhancing capacity building of parliamentarians through wider use of internet/online platforms to deal with extraordinary situation of Pandemic; (ii) Reaching out through e-Parliament for effective interface between the people and the parliament; and (iii) Strengthening the institutional capacity of Parliament by enhancing the technical skill of Members and staff of Parliament: Need to modernize, innovate and go virtual to meet new challenges.*

The Standing Committee approved the following Agenda topics for the 26th CSPOC, incorporating topics suggested by Hon'ble Speaker, Lok Sabha:

Topic 1: Parliaments and the pandemic

- How have parliaments adapted to the pandemic, what issues arose from the adaptations and which of these adaptations may become permanent.
- Parliamentary privilege and virtual proceedings.

Topic 2: Security

• The ever-evolving requirements for parliaments in relation to physical (premises and Members) and cyber security.

Topic 3: e-Parliament

- Technology driving evolving relationships between parliament and the people.
- The need for citizens to have access to technology to participate in new ways.

Topic 4: Role of the Speaker in leading parliamentary innovation;

Topic 5: Training for Members and staff
