

**MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING OF THE INDIAN
PARLIAMENTARY GROUP HELD ON WEDNESDAY, 13 AUGUST, 2014 IN
MAIN COMMITTEE ROOM , PARLIAMENT HOUSE ANNEXE**

The 52nd Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the Indian Parliamentary Group (IPG) was held on Wednesday, 13 August, 2014 from 1830 hrs to 2020 hrs in the Main Committee Room, Parliament House Annexe, New Delhi. Smt. Sumitra Mahajan, Hon'ble Speaker, Lok Sabha and President of the IPG, was in the Chair.

87 Members and Associate Members of the Indian Parliamentary Group were present.

At the outset, Hon'ble Speaker, Lok Sabha and President of the IPG, welcomed the Members to the Annual General Meeting.

Thereafter, Hon'ble Speaker, Lok Sabha and President of the Indian Parliamentary Group moved a resolution condoling the death of the Members of the Indian Parliamentary Group who passed away since the last Annual General Meeting held on 4 September, 2012. The Members, thereafter, observed silence for a minute as a mark of respect to the departed souls.

The Annual Reports of the Indian Parliamentary Group for the year 2012-2013 & 2013-2014 were, thereafter, considered and adopted without any amendments.

On the issue of election of Treasurer and members of the Executive Committee, Dr Karan Singh, MP moved the motion that the President be authorized to nominate the Treasurer as well as Members to the Executive Committee of the Indian Parliamentary Group. The motion was seconded by Shri Lakshminarayan Pandey and other Members of Indian Parliamentary Group. The motion was adopted by voice-vote.

It was also approved that the Pay & Accounts Officer, Lok Sabha may continue to be Auditor of the accounts of the Indian Parliamentary Group for the year 2014-2015.

The Members raised a number of issues relating to their pension, accommodation, Rail fare, passes, car labels, facilities in Library, CGHS, toll tax etc.

After a brief discussion, Hon'ble Speaker, Lok Sabha and President of the Indian Parliamentary Group expressed her thanks to all the Members and ensured them that she would personally look into the issues raised by them during the meeting.
